

GP Episode 3 Scene 9
(Female auditionee - role of SALLY MOSS)

INT DAY

The scene opens through the door of DR HATCHETT'S surgery. SALLY MOSS goes to sit down on a chair by DR HATCHETT'S desk. She puts her bag down at her feet and looks nervous.

HATCHETT

So, how can I help you today Ms... Moss?

SALLY (*hesitantly*)

Erm... well Doctor, I wanted to... come and see you today... as... well, there's something I... need to ask you... erm... how can I put this?...

HATCHETT

There's no need to be shy, you can tell me... I'm a doctor, I've heard it all before.

SALLY

Erm... well I...

HATCHETT

Yes?...

SALLY (*mortified with embarrassment*)

I... I want to go on the Pill.

HATCHETT

The contraceptive Pill? That's fine. How long have you been sexually active?

SALLY

What? Oh I'm... I'm not!

HATCHETT

Oh I'm sorry. Why do you feel the need then? Are you having menstrual problems?

SALLY

No! No, my periods are OK... well it's a pain that I have to have them, but no it's not that... it's just... better to be... erm... safe than sorry... you know?

HATCHETT

Right... yes... yes I think I do...
